


The Plan Member Receives an Encrypted Email from ATRF:

• You have received an encrypted email and see the following template in your inbox.



The first time you receive an encrypted email through this system at the associated email address, you will
need to register an account. This means registering the email account that you use to receive emails from
ATRF. It is a one-time registration where you enter your first name, last name, and create a password for
opening encrypted emails.

Note: If you change your email account, you will need to go through the registration process again to register your new email address.





• Click on "Read Message" and the following screen will appear. Your username will be your email address.






- Click on "Log In".

- Once the information is entered, click the check box beside "I agree to CRES's Terms of Service" and then click "Register".





• An email will be sent to your account to complete the final step for activation.




You will receive the following email, click on "Activate Account" to complete the registration process.

enter the password you created during the registration process to view the email.

Note: You will have three days to open the email before the expiry date is reached. If the email expires, please reach out to ATRF and we will extend the expiration window or resend the email.
